

Roberto de Mattei is Professor of Modern History and History of Christianity at the European University in Rome, and the author of more than a dozen books. A well-known commentator on Catholic affairs in his homeland, his incisive history of Vatican II was published in 2010, and is now available in English as *The Second Vatican Council – An Unwritten Story*.

John R.T. Lamont is a philosopher of religion and theologian based in Sydney, Australia. A significant contributor to the contemporary revival of Thomism, his work has appeared in leading academic journals as well as more popular periodicals such as *First Things*. His acclaimed study of the rational basis for Christian faith, *Divine Faith*, was published in 2004.
